The Funeral Director's Services

Our clients usually visualise a funeral which includes the removal of the deceased from the place of death, professional fees, preparation of the deceased, use of visitation rooms, cortege via a local address and provision of bearers for the funeral service.

To facilitate the above, our detailed pricing is as follows:

Professional Fees

Availability of professionally trained staff, arranging, co-ordinating and conducting the funeral, and attending to the relevant administration and legalities.

- Assistance with completion of necessary statutory documentation

Premises and Equipment
