HYMN

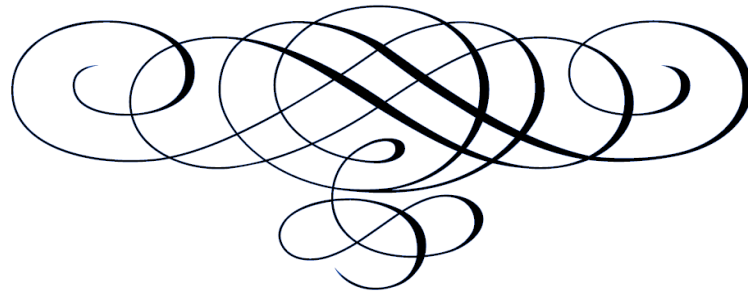
On a hill far away stood an old rugged cross,

Where his glory forever I'll share.

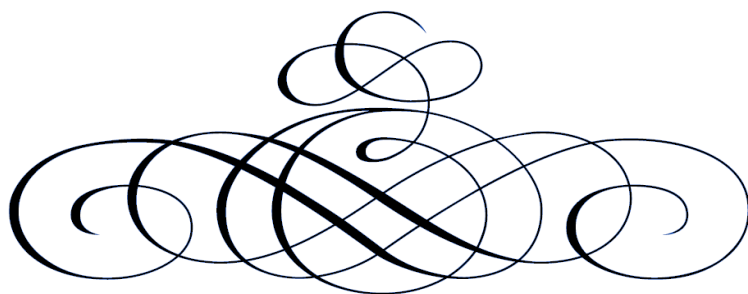
