#### HYMN


On a hill far away stood an old rugged cross, The emblem of suffering and shame; And I love that old cross where the dearest and best For a world of lost sinners was slain.

In the old rugged cross, stained with blood so divine, A won-drous beauty I see; For twas on that old cross Jesus suffered and died To pardon and sanctify me.


To the old rugged cross I will ever be true, Its shame and reproach gladly bear; Then he'll call me some day to my home far away, Where his glory forever I'll share.
