Was blind, but now I see

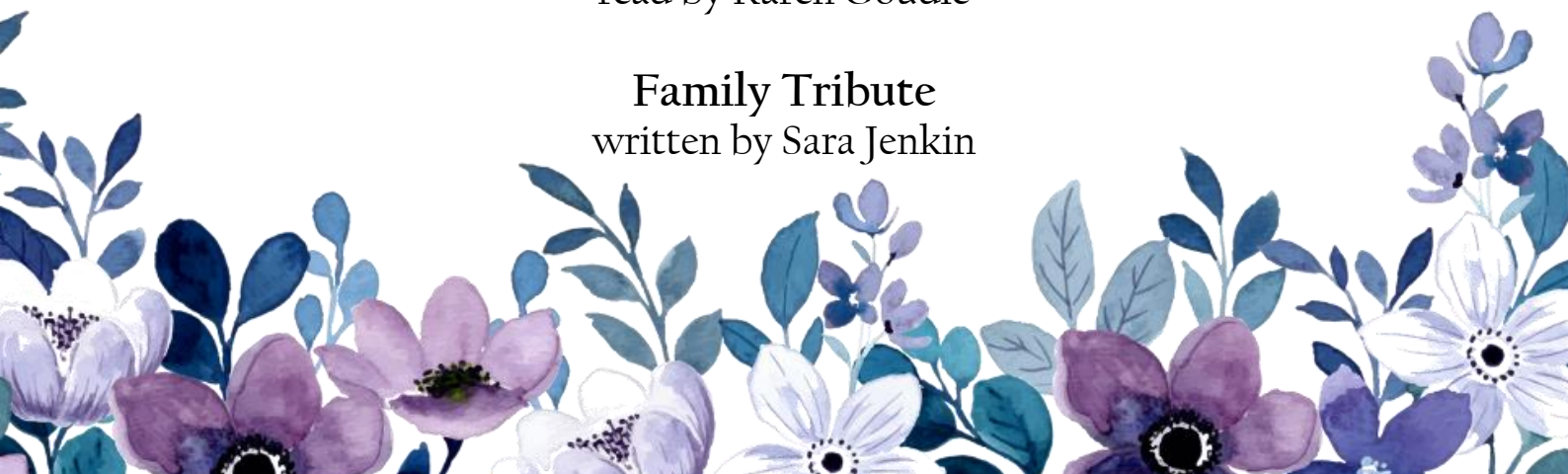
'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear
