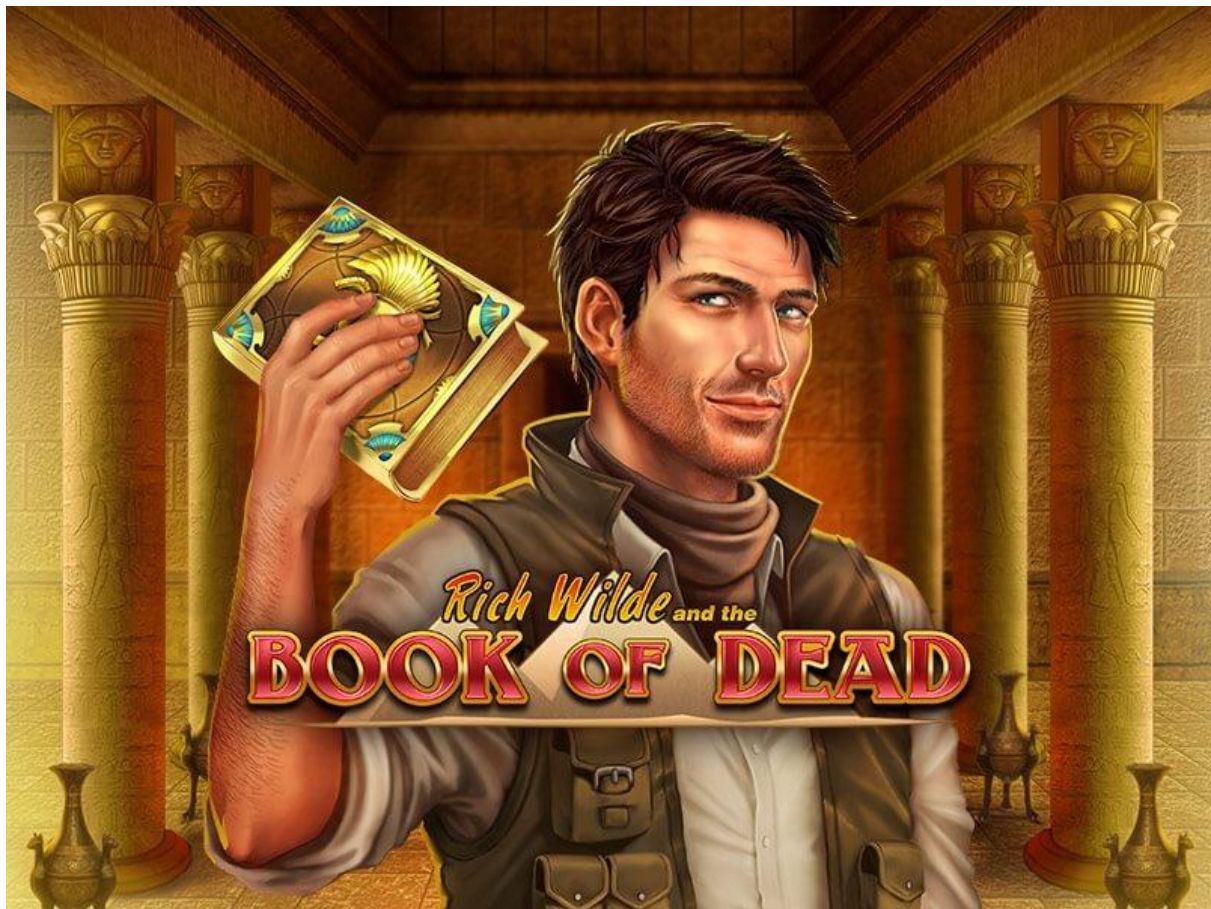


# Book of Dead Slot Overview

Adhere to a strict budget for your session before engaging the 'Spin' button.

Traditional in structure, the game offers 10 paylines, with bets ranging from 0.10 to 50.00.

All essential controls, including betting options, autoplay, payable information, and rules are conveniently located within the game menu, providing players with ample customisation.

## Payout & Volatility

'Rich Wilde and the Book of Dead' boasts an RTP of 96.6%. This high volatility slot promises significant returns, albeit with a higher level of risk.
