he made their tiny wings:

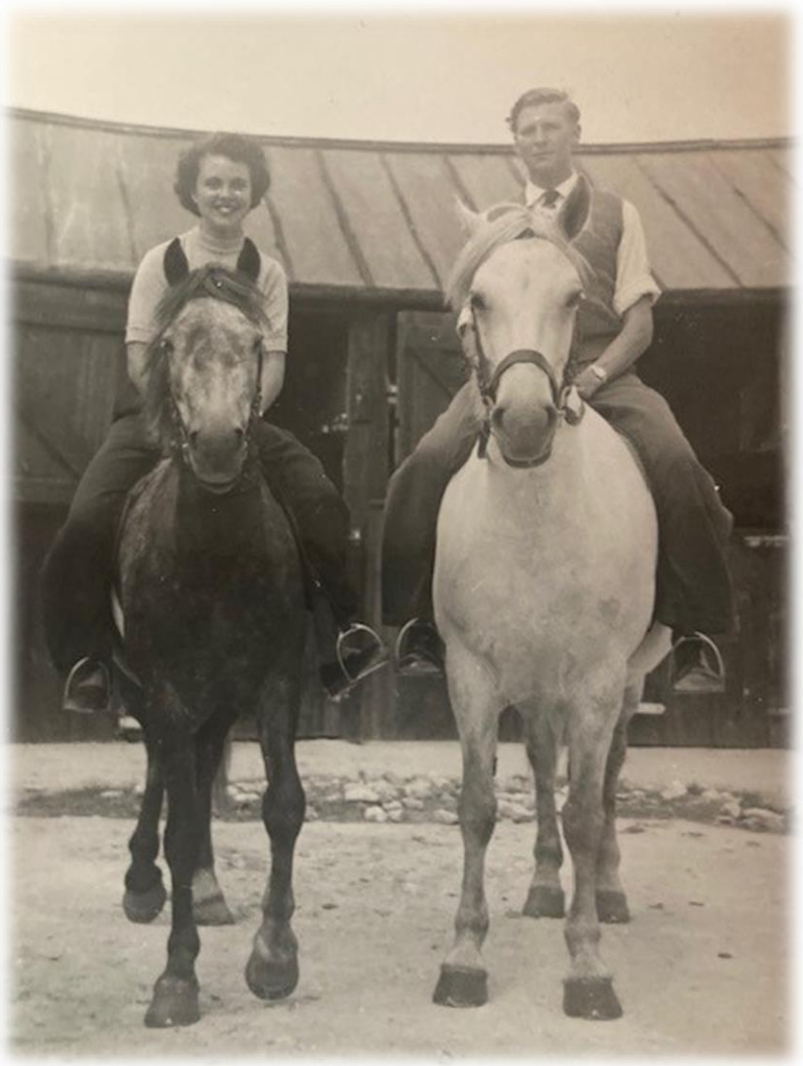
The cold wind in the winter,
