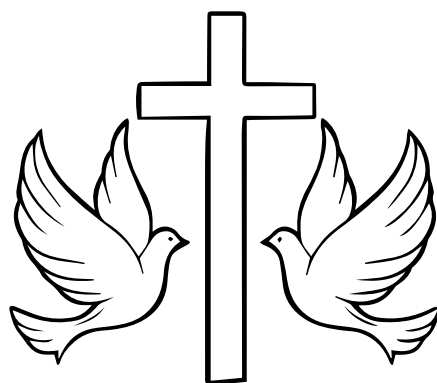

Amen.


