

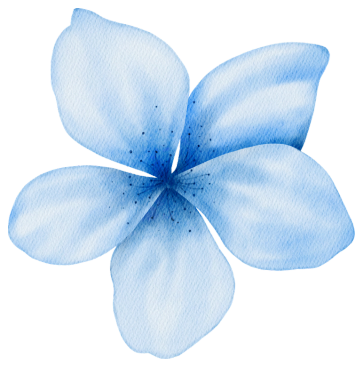

was blind, but now I see.

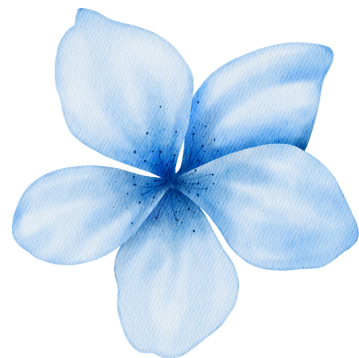
'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear,

the hour I first believed!

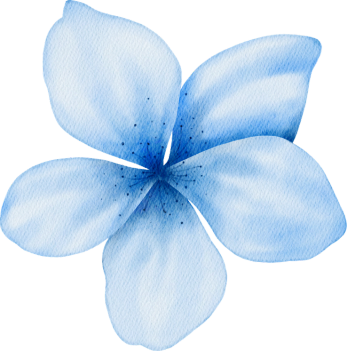
Through many dangers, toils and snares

Proverbs 31:25-31

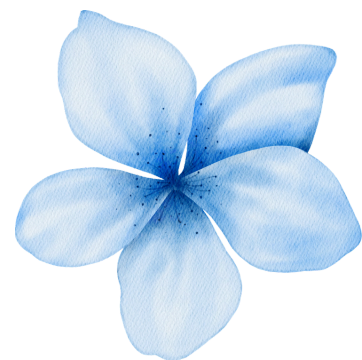
- <sup>25</sup> She is clothed with strength and dignity;

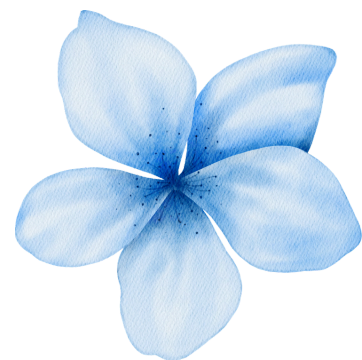
