Rescues us from all our foes:

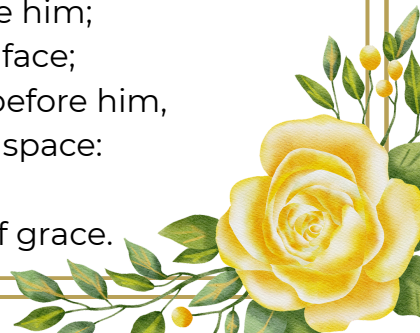
Alleluia! Alleluia!
